

3 Things to Know About HIV Treatment



The medicine people take for HIV is known as antiretroviral therapy (ART).



ART cannot cure HIV, but taking ART as directed prevents HIV from advancing to AIDS, helping people live long, healthy lives.



Taking ART can suppress HIV to undetectable levels, meaning it cannot be sexually transmitted. This is known as Undetectable = Untransmittable, or U=U.
